How to apply?

- Business must be in Indiantown and hold a current Martin County Business Tax Receipt
- Non-for-profit organizations are not eligible
- Complete BAP online application following link below (only \$25 fee to apply)

Once accepted...

Participants are required to attend **ALL** the BAP program classes, except for emergencies or previous communication with the organizers. The program consists of one 3-hour class during one weeknight per week (Monday) for a duration of 10 weeks. The \$25 program fee includes membership to the Business and Technology Incubator at IRSC. Participants who successfully complete the program (with no more than 1 missed class) are eligible to apply for a small business grant through the BAP program and Business Development Board of Martin County).
